Ms. Naema Foster & Mr. Foster (Parent) – Commented the classrooms are out of control. Went to see Principal to move child to a different classroom. Stated she was informed this could not be done because the Special Ed teacher is in the parent's classroom. Mr. Foster says the class are too disruptive.

Mr. Chase Kulter – Commented that Newark Charter Schools are some of the best in the country. Commented about saving money through a coalition to save money through energy savings.
