Daily Instructional Guidelines

- UHCS will utilize Zoom.com for our online virtual classroom platform. You can join through the calendar invite provided to you from your child's homeroom teacher.
- If you do not have a desktop or laptop computer, you can download the Zoom app through your cellular device app store.
- Classroom written communication (newsletters, assignments, etc.) will be provided through Google Classroom. Teachers have provided all scholars with their UHCS email addresses and passwords. You can utilize Google Classroom through your desktop or laptop computer. Google Classroom can also be downloaded through your cellular device app store.
- Instruction will be daily Monday Friday (see attached schedule). We will adhere to our school's calendar for scheduled closures.
- During live Zoom instruction, students are expected to adhere to the following guideline.
  - Proper attire
  - o Muted background unless interaction with teacher
  - Respectful to all participants
  - Minimal distractions
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Attend all session on time and for the allotted duration of instruction
  - Guardian present (nearby)
- Students are expected to complete their assigned practice work daily. Information regarding
  the submission of assignments is forthcoming. Students may also complete assignments/packets
  and submit them later in the day. Teachers will be available to assist from 1 pm 3 pm. Lessons
  will be recorded and made available upon request.
- A structured online schedule has been made available. Teachers will discuss the flexibility of lunches/breaks. Students will be permitted to take necessary breaks regarding screen-time
- Please note: If online instructional guidelines are not followed, the administration reserves the right to remove scholars from online learning. It will be the parent's responsibility to utilize the at-home learning work-packet available on the school's website.
- Daily instruction begins promptly at 9:00 am. Our live virtual learning ends at 1:00. Scholars are expected to complete intervention/enrichment support through our iReady platform for at least 30 minutes.
- Teachers will be available to answer questions through email or other means of provided communication by the teacher during check-ins. See schedule below

#### Work-Packets

- Work packets are accessible weekly through our school's website for download utilizing cellular devices or desktop/laptop
- Information regarding submission of assignments is forthcoming

#### Participation and Teacher Support

- All scholars are expected to participate in the online learning platform or by completing at home work-packets. Teachers will complete weekly check-ins. All online learners are expected to arrive and attend the full learning sessions on time
- Teachers, Support Staff, and Instructional Assistants will check in with families weekly.

#### Support Services

- Services that include tutoring, counseling, ESL, and other school-related services will be daily during 1:00 – 3:00. A UHCS staff member will contact the parent with their particular day and time.
- School Nurse will be available for support from 1 pm- 3 pm. Please check in with the nurse if your child is ill.
